BRIDGE NAVIGATIONAL WATCH ALARM SYSTEM (BNWAS)

The regulation will be approved as the revision of SOLAS on November 2008. The below vessel are applied.

1. Ships of 150 gross tonnage and upwards and passenger ships irrespective of size constructed after [1 July 2011]
2. Passenger ships irrespective of size constructed before [1 July 2011] not later than the first survey after [1 July 2012]
3. Ships of 3,000 gross tonnage and upwards constructed before [1 July 2011] not later than the first survey after [1 July 2012]
4. Ships of 500 gross tonnage and upwards but less than 3,000 gross tonnage constructed before [1 July 2011] not later than the first survey after [1 July 2013]
5. Ships of 150 gross tonnage and upwards but less than 500 gross tonnage

constructed before [1 July 2011]
not later than the first survey after [1 July 2014].

- ※1 Passenger Ship : Ship which carries more than twelve passengers.
- ※2 Cargo Ship : Ship which is not a passenger ship
